We are so excited to invite you to worship with us on June 28 at 9:00 am!

As you might expect, things will look a bit different than they did back in March. We wanted to let you know what to expect as you arrive back at your church.

- Everyone is required to wear a mask. If you need one, we will have some available
- As you arrive, you will be greeted. We will also record your attendance as a precautionary measure should you need to be contacted
- Our ushers will show you to your seat; we will be using every other pew to maintain social distancing
- Offering will not be collected during the service; however, offering plates will be on the table in the back of the sanctuary
- Initially, the children will remain with their parents during Children's Time
- At the end of the service, the ushers will dismiss from back row to front row

Best practices recommend that a few things will be temporarily missing:

- Hymnals and Bibles have been removed from the pews
- Prayer concerns will not be shared during the worship since it is being live streamed.
